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# Teaching Students to Work Discipline on the Basis of Folk Proverbs And Songs

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**Abstract:** In this article, it is effective to motivate elementary school students to work discipline through folk proverbs and songs, and one of the effective ways to motivate elementary school students is the issues of appropriate and motivating assessment criteria.

**Key words:** assimilation of educational materials, regular inspection of labor activities, practical knowledge.

Taking into account the mastering of students, i.e. determining the mastering of the previous educational materials during the consolidation of new material, mastering work methods and performing independent work tasks, graphic work and homework, and the knowledge of students is checked and evaluated.

Regularly checking and evaluating the students' educational and work activities ensures that they complete the assignments on time and independently. Encourages to diligently acquire scientific practical knowledge, work skills and qualifications. At the same time, the teacher and the teachers of industrial education are encouraged to identify the shortcomings of the students and to seek measures to correct them.

Labor education and directions are chosen in accordance with the fields and professions that are widespread in the economic area where the school and vocational college are located. Accordingly, it is necessary for local labor education teachers to develop their own evaluation criteria after choosing the direction. Below are general recommendations for developing these evaluation criteria:

- the following should be taken into account when developing criteria for evaluating students' theoretical, technical and technological knowledge in terms of initial skills;
- theoretical knowledge of technology, technique, economics, labor and organization of production;
- to know basic technological operations and technological processes;
- knowledge of basic tools and devices, their function;
- to know safety techniques and personal hygiene rules;
- to know the main sources, technical and didactic tools of education and their use;
- the ability to use relevant information on various educational subjects;
- independent performance, recovery, selection and other tasks;
- such as creative thinking and innovation during the lesson.

The teacher evaluates the students' knowledge and skills in a five-point system. 5- excellent, 4-good, 3- satisfactory, 2- bad, 1- very bad.

### Conclusion and methodical recommendations.

In Uzbekistan, it is the most necessary condition to satisfy the important needs of the society in the field of raising a mature generation. In order to satisfy society's need for highly qualified competitive personnel, they are constantly looking for ways to train specialists in labor classes. The purpose of this research is to educate students on labor discipline and guide them to the profession on the basis of folk

New forms and methods of improving personnel training were used during the research.
