Ensemble "Maqom" named after Yunus Rajabi The "Maqom" ensemble was founded in 1959 by the People's Artist of Uzbekistan, Academician Yunus Rajabi under the Uzbekistan Television and Radio Company.

Since 1962, the works included in the series "Shashmaqom" and "Tashkent-Fergana status roads" have been recorded for the first time by the ensemble. To date, the Difficult and Nasr sections of "Shashmaqom" have been rewritten 28 times by professional performers in Tajikistan The ensemble successfully participated in the 1979 maqam festival and in 1980 in Azerbaijan "Mugam" festivals, enjoying the masterpieces of our national maqam art with foreign maqam artists. Also, many artists who are loved by our people have grown up in this ensemble. Among them: artists of Uzbekistan Fahriddin Sadikov, Temur Mahmudov, Turgun Alimatov, People's Hafiz of Uzbekistan Israil and Ismail Vahobov, Makhmudjon Yoldoshev, Soyibjon Niyazov, Beknazar Dostmurodov, Abdunabi Ibragimov, People of Uzbekistan artist Abdulakhat Abdurashidov, Matluba Dadaboyeva, musicians such as Abdunabi Ziyoyev, Abdurahmon Holtojiyev, Tahirjon Turgunov, Komila Boriyeva, Sharofat Tojiboyeva, and singers Ozodbek Tillanazarov, Ozoda Yorova, Torabek Mukhtorov, Bobur Kenjayev are like.

# "Navroz" singing and dancing ensemble

"Navroz" singing and dancing ensemble was founded by Ravshanoy Sharipova in 2011. The ensemble continues to perform the traditions of Uzbek national dance art in accordance with modern dance requirements. The main goal of the ensemble is to widely promote our national dance art and further develop the Uzbek national dance art in a new style of performance in accordance with the requirements of the times. Artists who have served in Uzbekistan G`iyos Boytayev, Aziz Zaripov and singers Alijon Isakov and Olmas Olloberganov are working in the ensemble. Today, the ensemble is led by Zarina Akhmedova, winner of the "Shuhrat" medal. # Karakalpak song and dance ensemble

Uzbekistan and A. Sultanov, an artist who served in Karakalpakstan, founded the Karakalpak Song and Dance Ensemble in 1957 under the Karakalpak Republic TV and Radio Committee as part of the folk instrument orchestra. The "Ashula and Dance" ensemble separated from the orchestra in 1975. People's artists A.Atamuratova, S.Mambetova, Honored Artist of Uzbekistan B.Karimova, People's Artist of Karakalpakstan B.Utepbergenova, T.Kurbanov, Honored Artist of Karakalpakstan K.Niyettullayev have been part of the ensemble., T. # "Navbahor" singing and dancing ensemble

In 2014, the singing and dancing ensemble "Navbahor" was established. The ensemble includes 28 artists, including 11 musicians, 4 singers, and 11 ballet artists. Gulmira Madrahimova, an honored artist in Uzbekistan, leads the ensemble. The main goal of the creative team of the ensemble is to carefully study the masterpieces of the Uzbek national song and dance art and to present professional-level works of art to our artistic people. The team of the ensemble has been actively participating in many cultural events not only in our country, but also in foreign countries.

# "Lazgi" singing and dancing ensemble

"Lazgi" singing and dancing ensemble was founded in 1957 by Gavhar Rahimova. During the times when Komiljon Otaniyozov was the leader, it was called "Khorazm Song and Dance Ensemble".

Currently, this team is headed by Ogabek Sobirov.

#### Khorezm makomal ensemble

The Khorezm Makomchilar Ensemble was founded in 1966 under the leadership of Khojikhan Boltayev at the Urganch City House of Culture.

In 1988, a status team was formed at the Khorezm regional television and radio company, headed by Ruzmat Jumaniyazov, the People's Court of Uzbekistan. The main goal of the ensemble is to deeply study and promote the traditions of Khorezm maqam performance, to warm the young generation to the masterpieces of our national musical art. Also, "Khorazm Maqamchilar Ensemble" re-composed the lost parts of "Qal'abandi", "Roq" and "Panjgoh" series.
