of the nation is in the hands of mothers." ³ Today, based on many researches, by observing families, in a family where a woman is prudent, tasteful, fair-minded, intelligent, and can properly educate her child by paying attention to it in time, this family has more success. it was determined that virtuous people will be matured.⁴

During the search for methodological solutions to the problem, it is necessary to increase the sociopolitical and social activity of women in our country, to create conditions for them to realize their abilities and opportunities in various fields and sectors, and to ensure that their rights and legal interests are unconditionally respected. it is worth saying once again that large-scale work is being done in terms of provision, comprehensive support of motherhood and childhood, as well as strengthening of the family institution.⁵

In the process of increasing the all-round activity of women in society, let's name some urgent problems in the life of our country and society:

These complex problems were brought according to the decree No. PF-5325 signed by the President of our Republic on February 2, 2018:

- there is no targeted support system for women who are in need of help and who are in a difficult social situation, the practice of working individually with unemployed and socially inactive women has not been established, the activity of supporting employment and development of entrepreneurship among women is not organized at the final effective level;
- targeted work on preparing young people for family life, forming a modern exemplary family, strengthening its spiritual and moral foundations and traditional family values is not being carried out, the effectiveness of measures to prevent early marriages, conflict situations and divorces in families is low remains;
- the activities of protection of women's reproductive health are not sufficiently organized, there is no effective system for the prevention and prevention of maternal diseases and perinatal diseases, especially in remote rural areas;
- effective measures are not being taken to prevent offenses and crime among women, the mechanism of increasing the legal culture of women and providing them with legal advice does not meet the requirements of the time;

According to the results of foreign experiences, we are witnessing the following situation:⁶

- ✓ In 18 countries of the world, a husband can officially forbid his wife to work, in 39 countries the rights of boys and girls to inheritance are different, in 49 countries there are no laws prohibiting domestic violence;
- ✓ One in five women, including 19% of women between the ages of 15 and 49, reported being physically and/or sexually abused by a partner in the past 12 months;
- ✓ More than half (52 percent) of women aged 15 to 49, married or in a relationship, are independent in making decisions about sex, contraception, and health care. can only accept;

- \checkmark More than 100 countries of the world consider budget funds to promote gender equality;
- \checkmark in 46 countries, the share of women in at least one chamber of the parliament is 30 percent;
- ✓ Almost two-thirds of developing countries have achieved gender balance in primary education.

The degree of involvement of women in politics and decision-making processes is evaluated by various organizations. For example, as of January 1, 2021, data collected by the Inter-Parliamentary Association (IPU) can be cited. Below is the ranking of countries by the number of women in the legislative body of the lower house in different colors on the world map:

Generally speaking, our country is leading the ranks of foreign countries in increasing the sociopolitical and economic activity of women in society. This can be witnessed through the above statistical data and gender analysis.
