The captain of the first team calls out the name of one of the second team: White poplar, blue poplar! Who do you need from us? We need "so-and-so" from you.

After that, that called boy runs and tries to break the place where the members of the opposing team are holding hands with his chest. If the hands are broken from the place where they were caught, he takes any of the children from the opponent's side to his team, if not, he stays in that team. The game continues in this way. The team that has no players left wins.

Another one of our games is the chill game. This game is one of the games that are mainly played during Nowruz holiday.

Chillik game is the national game of the Uzbek people. For the game, a stick with a length of about one meter "Enasop" and a stick are prepared. The length of the stalk is 15-20 cm, both ends are pointed in the shape of a pencil. will be The purpose of this is to hit the tip of the chili while it is on the ground and lift it into the air. It is directed to a distance by hitting the air-raised chili with an enasop. The game of Chillik has started to fall out of favor in recent years. Nowruz is remembered and played in national elections. National games such as "Nongoq", "Kumtaka", "Lanka tepish", "Happak", "Kulok chozma", "Tapron", "Besh tash", "Chillik" were performed.

Another favorite game of our children is five stones. Five stones is a children's game. Five or more smooth and small stones are obtained. While holding one stone in one palm, the player must also knock another stone from the ground with the other hand, and each stone taken is kept in the player's hand. The player who collects all the stones without dropping a stone wins. Hand movements will increase this month.

Such wonderful games help children to quickly and easily understand our national values and national traditions. The events that are held during the holidays while preserving our nationality are also very effective. On our holidays, we wear our national costumes and sing our national songs, wearing wonderful dresses made of fabrics such as adras, satins, etc. Today, such wonderful holidays are also fun in preschool educational organizations. The joy on the faces of the little children is certainly a happy situation, if we say that the national clothes are the actions of our national traditions.

Among our national games are cockfighting, national wrestling, who will take this grudge, stone-stone game.
